The franchise offered is for the right to own and operate a single "911 Restoration" emergency response services business which provides emergency clean-up from fire damage, water damage and mold damage, as well as providing mold inspections, carpet cleaning, duct cleaning and crawl space cleaning. We offer both new start-up and conversion franchises.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a 911 Restoration franchise is \$35,000 to \$203,700. This includes approximately \$15,200 to \$61,200 that must be paid to the franchisor. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a conversion franchise is \$23,500 to \$195,700. This includes \$15,200 to \$61,200 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.
