We offer franchises for distinctive recreational entertainment facilities featuring trampolines, ropes and obstacle courses, and other activities, and offering and selling other related products and services under the "Altitude Trampoline Park®" name and marks. The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Altitude Trampoline Park® facility ranges from \$1,424,500 to \$3,923,500 (excluding the occupancy costs associated with the real estate for an Altitude Trampoline Park® facility). This includes \$40,000 that must be paid to us or our affiliates.

We also offer qualified persons the right to acquire an area development business to acquire franchises for and develop multiple "Altitude Trampoline Park®". The total investment necessary to begin operation of an area development business ranges from \$101,000 to \$106,000. This includes \$100,000 that must be paid to us. This estimated initial investment is based on our current minimum development commitment of 5 Parks. If we grant you an area development business, the initial development fee that you must pay us will be \$20,000 for each Park that you agree to develop. The estimated initial investment for an area development business does not include the cost of developing each Park required to meet the commitment under the area development agreement.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payments to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT REQUIRE YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US IN THE STATE IN WHICH OUR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS LOCATED (CURRENTLY, SOUTHLAKE, TEXAS). OUT OF STATE MEDIATION, ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO MEDIATE, ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE WITH US THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT STATE THAT TEXAS LAW GOVERNS THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT AND AREA DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. YOUR SPOUSE MUST SIGN A DOCUMENT THAT MAKES YOUR SPOUSE LIABLE FOR ALL FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT EVEN THOUGH YOUR SPOUSE HAS NO OWNERSHIP INTEREST IN THE FRANCHISE. THIS GUARANTEE WILL PLACE BOTH YOU AND OUR SPOUSE'S MARITAL AND PERSONAL ASSETS, PERHAPS INCLUDING YOUR HOUSE, AT RISK IF YOUR FRANCHISE FAILS.
