ADDENDUM TO ITEM 3

The following language is hereby incorporated into ITEM 3 of this Disclosure Document and made a part thereof

Neither we nor any broker or person identified in ITEM 2 is subject to any currently effective order of any national securities association or national securities exchange

APPLICABLE LAW

Except for matters relating to arbitration, trademarks, copyrights, and unfair competition, the Franchise Agreement requires application of the laws of Missouri This provision may not be enforceable under California Law

The Franchise Agreement provides for termination upon bankruptcy provision may not be enforceable under Federal Bankruptcy Law (11 USC Sec 101 et seq)

The Franchise Agreement contains a covenant not-to-compete which extends beyond the termination of the franchise This provision may not be enforceable under California law

Section 31125 of the California Corporations Code requires us to give you a disclosure document in a form approved by the Commissioner of Business Oversight prior to asking you for a material modification of an existing franchise agreement

California Business and Professions Code Sections 20000 through 20043 provide rights to the franchisee concerning termination or non-renewal of a franchise If the franchise agreement contains a provision that is inconsistent with the law, the law will control

The franchise agreement requires binding arbitration. The arbitration will occur in the St Louis, Missouri Metropolitan Area, with the prevailing party being entitled to

recover its reasonable attorneys' fees and expenses and the parties to bear evenly the panda company of the collection o of the arbitrators' fees and expenses



Prospective franchisees are encouraged to consult private legal counsel to determine the applicability of California and federal laws (such as Business and Professions Code Section 20040 5, Code of Civil Procedure Section 1281, and the Federal Arbitration Act) to any provisions of a franchise agreement restricting venue to a forum outside the State of California



You must sign a general release if you renew or transfer your franchise California Corporations Code § 31512 voids a waiver of your rights under the Franchise Investment Law (California Corporations Code §§ 31000 through 31516) Business and Professions Code § 20010 voids a waiver of your rights under the Franchise Relations Act (Business and Professions Code §§ 20000 through 20043 15)
