The franchisee will operate sit-down, table service Restaurants, including the service of food and alcoholic beverages, under the trade name of Applebee's Neighborhood Grill & Bar[®].

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Applebee's Neighborhood Grill & Bar® franchised business ranges from \$2,008,364 to \$7,654,395. This includes Initial Fees of \$35,000 to \$50,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate. You might pay the franchisor more if you sign a Development Agreement to develop multiple Restaurants.

This Franchise Disclosure Document (this "Disclosure Document") summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale or grant. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

- 1. THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AND FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRE THAT ALL DISAGREEMENTS BE LITIGATED IN THE STATE OF KANSAS. OUT OF STATE LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO SUE US IN KANSAS THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE DEVELOPMENT AGREEMENT AND FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATE THAT KANSAS LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENTS, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
