The franchise is for the operation of a residential homebuilding business of both single family and multi-family homes (the "ARTHUR RUTENBERG® Business(es)" or "Business(es)") using our System, including our Marks, Plans, Copyrights and Proprietary Software.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of the Business ranges from \$360,000 to \$637,000. This includes \$50,000 that must be paid to us or our affiliates.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT FLORIDA LAW GOVERNS THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW; YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

3. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE

We may use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you.
