The franchisee will operate a Fitness Revolution® adult fitness training center or an Athletic Revolution® youth fitness training center.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three (3) months of a complete Fitness Revolution franchise ("Fitness Revolution Franchise") is estimated to be from \$23,498.66 to \$120,918.90. This includes the initial franchise fee of \$7,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three months of a complete Fitness Revolution Franchise converted from an existing business is estimated to be from \$14,751.50 - \$42,993.90 or \$11,598.50 - \$39,840.90. This includes the 50% discounted initial franchise fee of \$3,750 or fully discounted initial franchise fee of 597.00 that must be paid to the franchisor respectively.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three months of a complete Fitness Revolution Franchise added on to an existing Athletic Revolution franchise is estimated to be from \$12,501.50 - \$40,743.90. This includes the eighty percent (80%) discounted initial franchise fee of \$1,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three months of a complete Athletic Revolution franchise ("Athletic Revolution Franchise") is estimated to be from \$30,156.50 - \$115,964.00. This includes the initial franchise fee of \$7,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three months of a complete Athletic Revolution franchise converted from an existing business and facility is estimated to be from \$21,106.50 - \$47,214.00. or \$17,953.50 - \$44,061.00. This includes the 50% discounted initial franchise fee of \$3,750 or the fully discounted initial franchise fee of 597.00 that must be paid to the franchisor respectively.

The total investment necessary to begin and maintain operations for at least three months of a complete Athletic Revolution Franchise added on to an existing Fitness Revolution franchise is Fitness Revolution/Athletic Revolution

estimated to be from \$18,856.50 - \$44,964.00. This includes the eighty percent (80%) discounted initial franchise fee of \$1,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.
