The total investment necessary to begin operation of an AvenueWest Business franchise is \$40,750 - \$78,200 including \$25,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 days before you sign a binding agreement or make any payment in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
