The total investment necessary to begin operation of a typical 95-room avid<sup>™</sup> hotel, excluding land costs and other matters, ranges from \$7,116,285 to \$9,694,545 (\$74,908 to \$102,048 per guest room) or more (see Item 7), including between \$128,540 and \$157,350 or more that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate (see Item 5).

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
