An Avis Franchise is a business of renting automobiles, without drivers, to the general public, for periods of 180 days, or less under the Avis Trademarks

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Avis Franchise, assuming that you finance 100% of your rental car fleet, ranges from \$602,240 to \$1,554,575 for an Avis Franchise with a 30-car fleet and a territory of 55,000 people. This includes initial license purchase fees of \$30,000 for a territory with a population of 55,000.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying exhibits carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read your entire contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind.
