The franchise offered is to operate a bakery food service establishment offering bakery products, gourmet coffees and teas, coffee or tea-based beverages, compatible food products, accessories and gifts

If you sign franchise agreement, the initial fees is US\$80,000 franchise fee for a single Bake Code bakery with central kitchen plus a US\$35,000 of technology transfer fee and a minimum of US\$80,000 of opening inventory (for details please see Item 5 of this Franchise Disclosure Document) A franchise agreement may also grant you the option to establish maximum two satellite Bake Code bakeries, with the initial fees is US\$50,000 franchise fee for a single satellite Bake Code bakery plus a US\$20,000 of technology transfer fee and a minimum of US\$10,000 to US\$55,000 of opening inventory The estimated initial investment may be up to US\$796,000 to US\$1,021,500 per each bakery with central kitchen, and US\$341,000 to US\$531,000 per each satellite bakery (for details please see Item 7 of this Franchise Disclosure Document)

- 1 THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT INCLUDES A PROVISION FOR LIQUIDATED DAMAGES IN THE AMOUNT OF US\$20,000 FOR BUYING AN UNAUTHORIZED SUPPLIERS AND US\$10,000 FOR ALL OTHER VIOLATIONS THESE PROVISIONS MAY NOT BE ENFORCEABLE IN THE STATE YOU ARE DOING BUSINESS
- 2 YOU MUST MODIFY OR DISCONTINUE USE OF A BAKE CODE TRADEMARK AT YOUR OWN EXPENSE IF BAKE CODE MODIFIES THE TRADEMARK OR DISCONTINUES ITS USE
- 3 THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT HAS A TERM OF 3 YEARS YOU MAY BE ASKED TO SIGN A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH MATERIALLY DIFFERENT TERMS AND YOU MUST PAY A RENEWAL FEE THAT SHALL NOT EXCEED 80% OF THE INITIAL FRANCHISE FEES
- 4 YOU WILL NOT RECEIVE AN EXCLUSIVE TERRITORY YOU MAY FACE COMPETITION FROM OTHER FRANCHISEES, FROM OUTLETS THAT WE OWN, OR FROM OTHER CAHNNELS OF DISTRIBUTION OR COMPETITIVE BRANDS THAT WE CONTROL
- 5 THIS FRANCHISOR HAS BEEN OFFERING FRANCHISES FOR A SHORT PERIOD OF TIME THEREFORE, THERE IS ONLY A BRIEF OPERATING HISTORY TO ASSIT YOU IN JUDGING WHETHER OR NOT TO MAKE THIS INVESTMENT
- 6 THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT CONTAINS PROVISIONS THAT LIMT FRANCHISEE'S RIGHTS AND MAY NOT BE ENFORCEABLE IN CALIFORNIA, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO, A TIME LIMIT TO WAIVER OF JURY TRIAL, WAIVER OF PUNITIVE DAMAGES, OR EXEMPLARY DAMAGES AND LIMITATIONS ON WHETHER CLAIMS MAY BE RAISED
