As a Big Mama's & Papa's Pizzeria franchisee you will operate within a defined territory either a full size pizzeria or a smaller Pronto outlet, both providing a variety of pizzas with unique sizes, salads, sandwiches, specialty condiments and ingredients, and other authorized food, beverages and related products and accessories

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Big Mama's & Papa's Pizzeria is \$359,500 to \$660,000. This includes \$25,000 that must be paid to the franchisor and its affiliates.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
