As a Bizzie Franchisee, you will service laundry and dry cleanable goods and soft contents to and from a locker-based system. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Bizzie Franchise is approximately between \$29,100 and \$80,760. This includes a \$10,000 Initial Franchise Fee, a \$15,600 BizzieBox Purchase fee, and shipping fees for the BizzieBoxes ranging from \$0 to \$4,100 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate before opening.

You should consult Items 5-7 of this Disclosure Document for further information concerning the total investment required.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the Disclosure Document alone to understand your contract. Read the entire contract carefully. Show your contract and this Disclosure Document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this Disclosure Document can help you make up your mind.
