You will open and operate a region consisting of referral groups composed of non-competing business professionals known as Chapters. Each of the Chapters will have members that are business professionals that your franchise will train and instruct as to how to grow each one's own business through qualified referrals using the structure and format provided by us. If you or your group members make referrals to broker-dealers or investment advisers, you or your group members may be subject to additional licensing requirements in certain states.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a BNI franchise is between \$60,28066,080 and \$88,78092,480. This includes between \$53,28059,080 and \$62,28065,980 (Initial Fee, Training Fee, Initial Supplies, and Video Conferencing License) that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s).

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Do not rely on the Disclosure Document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contracts carefully. Show your contract and this Disclosure Document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this Disclosure Document can help you make up your mind. More information on franchising, such as "A Consumer's Guide to Buying a Franchise," which can help you understand how to use this Disclosure Document, is available from the Federal Trade Commission.
