The franchise offered is for the business of selling retail furniture and related products, under the name of BoConcept® and which is owned by BOCONCEPT FRANCHISE, INC and its affiliated companies. The initial entrance or franchise fee is \$30,000 00 for a franchise, as described in Items 5 and 6. The amount of the franchise fee may vary dependent upon the location of a franchise and the number of franchises purchased. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a BoConcept Franchise, Inc., franchised business is between \$375,612 00 to \$789,212 00, dependent upon the size and location of each store. This includes \$30,000 00 franchise fee and between \$95,000 00 and \$160,000 00 for initial inventory including accessories and furniture product displays, and between \$15,000 00 and \$30,000 00 for store. Buildout/shopfitter, and an initial fee of \$2,023 00 for AXAPTA (inventory, sales, delivery software) and User license of \$7,689 00, that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliates as the initial fees described in Item 7.
