BODYTEK fitness studios provide membership-based total body workout facilities for use by the general public, offer physical fitness and exercise services, consisting mainly of total body workout instruction, and sell related products in connection therewith, such as clothing, accessories, and health supplements. Total body training continues to be one of the most solid fitness growth modalities in the fitness industry. A BODYTEK membership gives customers access to such physical fitness and exercise services and training. BODYTEK fitness studios are open seven (7) days a week, but hours of operation may vary.

The total initial investment necessary to begin operation of a BODYTEK franchise is estimated to range from \$207,900 - \$373,000 the total amount of **Item 7**. This includes an initial franchisee fee in the amount of \$19,900, the total amount of **Item 5**, which must be paid to the franchisor. BODYTEK FITNESS FRANCHISING INC. offers two (2) types of franchises: If you want development rights, you generally must pay us a development fee of up to \$9,950, plus an initial franchisee fee in the amount of \$19,900; for each additional BODYTEK studio (see **Item 5** and **Item 7** for more detailed information).

This Franchise Disclosure Document (hereinafter, the "FDD") summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this FDD and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this FDD at least fourteen (14) calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

You may wish to receive your FDD in another format that is more convenient for you. - 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION ONLY IN BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA. OUT-OF-STATE ARBITRATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE WITH US IN FLORIDA THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT FLORIDA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTION AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
