As a Bowl of Heaven franchisee you will operate a retail restaurant in a defined territory providing Acai bowls, exotic juice blend smoothies, bread, specified condiments and ingredients, other food, beverages, related products and accessories.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Bowl of Heaven retail restaurant is \$161,500 to \$438,500. This includes \$35,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
