Buck's Pizza Franchising Corporation, Inc. ("we" or "us") is offering franchises to "Area Directors" to solicit and refer to us qualified prospective "Buck's Pizza" franchisees located in particular geographic areas, and to provide site selection and support services to those franchisees.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Area Director franchise is \$45,800 to \$281,500. This includes \$24,800 to \$250,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind. - 2. THE AREA DIRECTOR MARKETING AGREEMENT STATES THAT PENNSYLVANIA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
