The franchise offered is for the establishment and operation of business providing professional junk-removal services to residential and small business customers, with a strong “eco-friendly” focus.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Bumblejunk franchise is from \$102,850 to \$154,100. This includes \$36,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

3. WE AND YOU EACH IRREVOCABLY WAIVE TRIAL BY JURY IN ANY ACTION, WHETHER AT LAW OR EQUITY, BROUGHT BY EITHER OF US.

4. SPOUSES OF FRANCHISE OWNERS MUST SIGN A PERSONAL GUARANTY WHICH MAY PLACE THEIR PERSONAL AND MARITAL ASSETS AT RISK.

5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
