Camp Bow Wow Franchising, Inc. franchises the right to operate "CAMP BOW WOW®" businesses offering specialized pet care services through fixed store locations and mobile units, the retail sale of pet food and merchandise, and related services and products.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Camp Bow Wow franchised business ranges from \$718,500 to \$1,457,500. This total investment includes \$32,500 - \$50,000 that must be paid to us or our Affiliates.

In certain circumstances, we offer to those who qualify the opportunity to acquire the right to develop and operate at least three Camp Bow Wow franchised businesses in a designated development area. In addition to the total investment necessary to begin operation of the first Camp Bow Wow franchised business, as described above, you must pay us a development fee for each subsequent Camp Bow Wow franchised business that you agree to open in the designated development area. The current development fee is \$50,000 (the initial franchise fee for your first franchised business) plus \$37,500 for each additional franchised business to be opened in the development area.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of the Camp Bow Wow® Franchise Agreement, Multi-Unit Development Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to us, or an Affiliate, in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

You may wish to receive your Disclosure Document in another format that is more convenient for you. How to Use This Franchise Disclosure Document

Here are some questions you may be asking about buying a franchise and tips on how to find more information:

QUESTION	WHERE TO FIND INFORMATION
How much can I earn?	Item 19 may give you information about outlet sales, costs, profits or losses. You should also try to obtain this information from others, like current and former franchisees. You can find their names and contact information in Item 20 or Exhibit E.
How much will I need to invest?	Items 5 and 6 list fees you will be paying to the franchisor or at the franchisor's direction. Item 7 lists the initial investment to open. Item 8 describes the suppliers you must use.
Does the franchisor have the financial ability to provide support to my business?	Item 21 or Exhibit C includes financial statements. Review these statements carefully.
Is the franchise system stable, growing, or shrinking?	Item 20 summarizes the recent history of the number of company-owned and franchised outlets.
Will my business be the only Camp Bow Wow® business in my area?	Item 12 and the "territory" provisions in the franchise agreement describe whether the franchisor and other franchisees can compete with you.
Does the franchisor have a troubled legal history?	Items 3 and 4 tell you whether the franchisor or its management have been involved in material litigation or bankruptcy proceedings.
What's it like to be a Camp Bow Wow® franchisee?	Item 20 or Exhibit E lists current and former franchisees. You can contact them to ask about their experiences.
What else should I know?	These questions are only a few things you should look for. Review all 23 Items and all Exhibits in this disclosure document to better understand this franchise opportunity. See the table of contents.
