As a CANDY EXPRESS franchisee, you will operate a retail store that sells pre-packaged and bulk candy, confections, gifts, and related items. As a COCO MOKA CAFE franchisee, your store will sell gourmet coffee, soups, salads, sandwiches, ice cream, desserts and pastries.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a CANDY EXPRESS franchised business is \$142,556 to \$385,080. This includes \$30,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a COCO MOKA CAFÉ franchised business is \$149,350 to \$499,400. This includes \$33,000 to \$40,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in the document.

YOU MAY HAVE TO SIGN A NEW AGREEMENT WITH DIFFERENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE YOUR BUSINESS. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO INITIALLY RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION ONLY IN MARYLAND. IT MAY COST MORE TO ARBITRATE WITH US IN MARYLAND THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PERMITS YOU TO SUE US ONLY IN MARYLAND. OUT OF STATE LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO SUE US IN MARYLAND THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 3. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT MARYLAND LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 4. OUR FEBRUARY 28, 2014 AUDITED FINANCIAL STATEMENTS SHOW THAT WE HAD A WORKING CAPITAL DEFICIENCY OF \$537,263, A RETAINED EARNINGS DEFICIT OF \$537,263, AND A DEFICIT IN STOCKHOLDER EQUITY OF \$501,664, WHICH INDICATE WE MAY NOT BE ABLE TO MEET OUR OBLIGATIONS.
- 5. YOU MUST GIVE US A FIRST PRIORITY SECURITY INTEREST IN ALL OF YOUR LEASEHOLD IMPROVEMENTS, FURNITURE, FIXTURES, MACHINERY, EQUIPMENT, INVENTORY AND ANY OTHER PROPERTY THAT IS PART OF YOUR BUSINESS, WHICH MAY PLACE THOSE ASSETS AT RISK.
- 6. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
