You will operate a business as a carpet, tile, grout, hard surface floor, upholstery and fabric cleaning business. You will offer and sell carpet, tile, grout, hard surface floor, upholstery and fabric cleaning services. You will provide the services and products operating under the Marks and using the System.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Carpet Cops franchised business is from \$82,725 to \$103,750. This includes an initial fee of \$26,500 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. - 5. THE FRANCHISOR HAS LIMITED CAPITAL RESOURCES. SEE THE FRANCISOR'S FINANCIAL STATEMENTS FOR DETAILS. THIS COULD RESULT IN THE FRANCHISOR BEING UNABLE TO MEET CURRENT OBLIGATIONS.
