We offer an area development franchise to provide services to operate cell phone repair businesses within specified geographic areas using the "CPR" marks that provide repair services we authorize for smart phones, cell phones, laptops, game systems and other electronic devices.

# **Area Representative:**

The total investment necessary to begin operation under the area representative agreement depends on the size of the population of the development area using the most recent U.S. census bureau and the number of Cell Phone Repair Units Area Representative will be receive the right to own and operate in the development area. The required minimum population of a development area is 2 million people. The total minimum investment required to establish an Area Representative ranges from \$91,000 to \$181,200. This includes the \$80,000 which is payable to us or our affiliates. Area Representatives are also required to operate at least one Standard Market Cell Phone Repair business. The information for this offering is contained in a separate Franchise Disclosure Document.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your area representative agreement and other information in plain English. Read the Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payments to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.

You may wish to receive your disclosure document in another format that is more convenient for you. ARBITRATION AND/OR LITIGATION PROCEEDINGS WILL TAKE PLACE IN CLEVELAND, OHIO. OUT OF STATE ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST MORE TO ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE WITH US IN CLEVELAND, OHIO THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE AREA REPRESENTATIVE AGREEMENT STATES THAT OHIO LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
