The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Checkers Restaurant is \$453,000 to \$627,200 (excluding real estate and related costs) is as follows: \$345,500 to \$825,000 for a traditional double drive-thru modular building: \$373,500 to \$525,000 for a prototype single drive-thru freestanding restaurant; \$131,200 to \$683,500 for a conversion of a free-standing restaurant; \$391,300 to \$688,800 for an end-cap strip-center restaurant; \$239,325 to \$568,700 for an in-line restaurant in a high density market; and \$111,100 to \$325,000 for the reopening of a closed Checkers or Rally's restaurant.
