The franchise offered is to operate a Checkers Restaurant or Rally's Restaurant featuring a limited menu of hamburgers, cheeseburgers, hot dogs and other menu items

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Checkers Restaurant or Rally's Restaurant (excluding real estate and related costs) is \$569,900 to \$689,900 for a new modular design single drive thru restaurant, \$96,414 to \$1,501,265 for a site built, conversion or used modular drive thru restaurant, \$149,518 to \$839,848 for an endcap strip center and gas/convenience restaurant, and \$189,560 to \$871,988 for a Non Traditional, Walmart or in line restaurant in a high density market This includes \$10,000 to \$50,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate, plus \$10,000 for each additional restaurant that you agree to develop under a development agreement with us

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other agreements and information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the franchise sale.
