The franchised business you will own and operate is a restaurant serving gourmet cheeseburgers and other food and beverage products, including beer and wine as a full-service, sit down restaurant.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Cheeburger Cheeburger Franchise ranges from \$425,250 to \$577,500 for a Traditional Franchised Outlet and from \$215,250 to \$421,500 for a Non-Traditional Franchised Outlet. This includes \$13,750 to \$27,500 that must be paid to us or our affiliate.

We also offer to certain qualified persons rights to develop a number of Cheeburger Cheeburger Franchises within a given exclusive Development Area in accordance with a Development Schedule under a Cheeburger Cheeburger Development Agreement. There is no additional Development Fee. If you open 2 Outlets, the total investment necessary to begin operation of 2 Cheeburger Cheeburger Franchise ranges from \$850,500 to \$1,155,000 for 2 Traditional Franchised Outlets and from \$430,500 to \$843,000 for 2 Non-Traditional Franchised Outlets. This includes \$27,500 to \$55,000 that must be paid to s or our affiliate.

This Franchise Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Franchise Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Franchise Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, us or our affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
