The franchises offered are for the operation of a More Space Place retail furniture store, specializing in space-saving furniture products, some of which are proprietary or the operation of a Closet & Storage Concepts business providing for the designing, marketing, construction and installing of residential and commercial storage space including closets, garages, and other storage areas for consumers and the selling of related accessories in a retail showroom

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a More Space Place franchised business is \$90,950 to \$172,150 This includes \$40,750 to \$62,250 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s)

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Closet & Storage Concepts franchised business is \$69,500 to \$486,000 This includes \$21,800 to \$72,300 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s)
