The franchisee will operate a hotel under the "Coast" brand and franchisee will participate in the advertising, marketing, reservation system, and quality standards designed and implemented by Coast Hotels USA, LLC. You will be required to pay an initial franchise fee of \$200 per guest room in your hotel. The initial investment is estimated to be between \$27,500 to \$311,000. This sum does not include the purchase or lease of a hotel.

This disclosure document ("Disclosure Document") summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agrees carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with , or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. NOTE, HOWEVER, THAT NO GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY HAS VERIFIED THE INFORMATION CONTAINED IN THIS DOCUMENT.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.
