The franchise offered is for the operation of a College Nannies, Sitters and Tutors[™] business which will offer nanny placement services, babysitting services, homework help tutoring and college prep services

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a College Nannies, Sitters and Tutors business is from \$149,000 to \$224,500. This includes the \$39,500 initial franchise fee that must be paid to us. If you purchase 2 franchised territories at the same time, the Initial Franchise Fee is \$68,000 for both. If you purchase 3 franchised territories at the same time, the Initial Franchise Fee is \$96,000 for all 3.
