The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Complete Nutrition franchise located in a small store market ranges from \$170,450 to \$188,450 to ~~\$349,700 to \$412,950~~. This estimate includes a range of ~~\$58,500 to \$105,000 that must be paid to us~~ \$54,750 to \$95,250 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Complete Nutrition franchise located in a larger store market ranges from \$188,450 to \$392,950. This estimate includes a range of \$54,750 to \$72,250 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate. You might pay us more if you sign a Development Rights Agreement for multi-unit development.— (see Item 5).
