The franchise described in this Disclosure Document is for the operation of a business which teaches children in preschools, daycare centers, and other similar venues how to operate and maintain computers (the "Franchise" or the "Franchise Business").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a CompuChild franchise is \$18,500 to \$33,600 for a *Standard Franchise* and \$18,300 to \$28,000 for a *Mini-Territory Franchise*. This includes \$12,500 to \$17,500 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate. If you sign an Area Development Agreement to open more than one franchise store, the total investment necessary to begin operation is \$18,500 to \$33,600 plus an Area Development Fee of \$5,000 for each additional franchise you will develop. The fee is credited toward the franchise fee due for each additional franchise you develop.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of the Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payments to us or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the Disclosure Document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this Disclosure Document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.
