The franchise is for a real estate brokerage offering with defined real estate brokerage services from a specified location under the name Corcoran<sup>®</sup>.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Corcoran<sup>®</sup> franchise is approximately \$43,850 to \$231,200 for a conversion real estate office, and \$153,350 to \$518,500 for a start-up real estate office. This includes \$10,000 to \$35,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate as an initial franchise fee. The initial franchise fee for a residential franchise is \$35,000 for the first Branch Office and \$10,000 for each additional Branch Office.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale or grant. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don't rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of your contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind. - 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY LITIGATION ONLY IN NEW JERSEY. OUT-OF-STATE LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO LITIGATE WITH US IN NEW JERSEY THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
