CORE Group Restoration franchises provide disaster recovery and property damage restoration services to residential and commercial customers using the CORE Group Restoration name and marks ("<u>CORE Business(es)</u>"). We offer multi-unit franchises ("<u>Multi-Unit Franchise(s)</u>") for the right to open multiple CORE Businesses.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single CORE Group Restoration franchised business is between \$76,000 and \$371,150. This includes \$50,000 to \$93,150 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s).

The total investment necessary to begin operation of two CORE Businesses under a Multi-Unit Franchise is between \$127,000 and \$742,300. This includes \$75,000 to \$186,300 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s). The total investment necessary to begin operation of ten CORE Businesses under a Multi-Unit Franchise is between \$335,000 and \$3,111,500. This includes \$150,000 to \$331,500 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s).

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive the disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

YOU MAY HAVE TO SIGN A NEW AGREEMENT WITH DIFFERENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN ORDER TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE YOUR BUSINESS. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY MEDIATION OR ARBITRATION ONLY IN THE PRINCIPAL CITY CLOSEST TO OUR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS OR BY LITIGATION IN THE STATE OR FEDERAL COURT IN WHICH OUR PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS IS LOCATED (CURRENTLY AUSTIN, TEXAS). OUT-OF-STATE MEDIATION/ARBITRATION/LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO MEDIATE/ARBITRATE/LITIGATE WITH US IN TEXAS THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT TEXAS LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. YOUR SPOUSE MUST SIGN A DOCUMENT, SUCH AS A GUARANTEE, THAT MAKES YOUR SPOUSE LIABLE FOR YOUR FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS UNDER THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT EVEN IF YOUR SPOUSE DOES NOT OWN ANY PART OF THE FRANCHISE BUSINESS. BOTH YOU AND YOUR SPOUSE'S MARITAL AND PERSONAL ASSETS, INCLUDING YOUR HOUSE, COULD BE LOST IF YOUR FRANCHISE FAILS.
- 4. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We may use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source is our agent and represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
