The total estimated initial investment required for a Deli Delicious™ express model ranges from \$116,800 to \$245,300 or from \$217,850 to \$462,150 for a Deli Delicious™ standard model depending on a number of factors that are more fully discussed in Item 7. This includes the Initial Franchise Fee of \$20,000 for an express model or \$25,000 for a standard model (as discussed in Item 5) that must be paid to the Franchisor or the Franchisor’s affiliate.
