The franchise offered is for the operation of a service which provides training, continuing education, marketing support, software access and support, call and letter writing center, and back office support for dentists who want to provide and implement treatment alternatives for snoring and obstructive sleep apnea and related sleep disordered breathing issues using Orthotic Appliance Therapy ("Franchised Business"). The total investment necessary to begin the operation of a DENTAL SLEEP SOLUTIONS Franchised Business is \$39,500 to \$45,500, which includes \$25,000 that must be paid to the franchisor.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale.
