The franchise is for the establishment and operation of a full service skin treatment center business under the name Dermatone SpaTM which offers skin tightening and rejuvenation treatments, body slimming treatments, hair removal services, wellness and massage services and other related offerings (a "**Dermatone SpaTM franchise**" or "**Franchised Business**").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single-unit Dermatone SpaTM franchise ranges from \$99,500 to \$178,500. This includes a \$45,000 initial franchise fee that must be paid to us. We will, upon request, finance up to \$18,000 of the initial franchise fee, or 40%. If a franchise chooses to develop multiple units, a \$25,000 initial franchise fee must be paid for the second and each additional unit. There is no financing available for the franchise fees for additional units.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY MEDIATION OR LITIGATION ONLY IN FLORIDA. OUT OF STATE MEDIATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO MEDIATE OR LITIGATE WITH US IN FLORIDA THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT STATES THAT FLORIDA LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.

WE AND OUR AFFILIATES MAY ESTABLISH OTHER FRANCHISED OR COMPANY OWNED LOCATIONS AND OTHER CHANNELS OF DISTRIBUTION, AND MAY SELL OR DISTRIBUTE ANY PRODUCT OR SERVICE UNDER THE SAME AND/OR DIFFERENT TRADEMARKS TO THE GENERAL PUBLIC IN COMPETITION WITH YOUR FRANCHISE.
- 4. AS THE OWNER OF A FRANCHISED LOCATION, UPON EARLY TERMINATION OF THE FRANCHISE, YOU MUST PAY US LIQUIDATED DAMAGES IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE AVERAGE MONTHLY ROYALTY FEES DURING THE 12 MONTHS PRIOR TO TERMINATION MULTIPLIED BY 18 OR THE NUMBER OF MONTHS REMAINING IN THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT, WHICHEVER IS LESS.
- 5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

We use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
