We offer franchises for the operation of "Dr. G's" clinics, which may be operated from a retail storefront located in a strip mall, shopping center or other similar location ("Dr. G's Clinic"). While the "Dr. G's" business model requires that you engage the services of a licensed M.D. at every location, you will not be permitted to engage in the practice of medicine.

The total investment necessary to begin operating a Dr. G's franchise is \$147,900 to \$217,500 if you operate from a Co-Located Facility and \$225,150 to \$506,000 if you operate from a Stand-Alone Facility, including the \$75,000 initial franchise fee that must be paid to the Franchisor.

We are offering to certain qualified people the right to become an Area Director. The total investment necessary to begin operating as a Dr. G's Area Director franchise will range from \$250,000 to \$2,000,000 depending on the size of the development area. The estimated initial investment will vary based on the number of stores to be developed. An Area Director must own and operate one Dr. G's Clinic.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully.
