The franchise owner will provide HVAC cleaning and restoration services for residential and commercial dwellings and buildings, utilizing the DUCTZ business system, which is sometimes referred to below as the “Franchise”, “Franchised Business” or “DUCTZ Franchise.”

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a DUCTZ franchise is from \$77,524 to \$120,499. This includes from \$59,650 that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Don’t rely on the disclosure document alone to understand your contract. Read all of the contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Buying a franchise is a complex investment. The information in this disclosure document can help you make up your mind.
