The franchisee will operate one or more retail transmission shops specializing in the repair and replacement of motor vehicle transmissions. The shops may also offer additional automotive repair services.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Eagle Transmission franchise is from \$221,000 \$194,000 to \$338,500 \$282,500. These sums do not include rent for the transmission shop. This includes \$35,000 \$28,000 Franchise Fee that must be paid to the franchisor, plus \$3,500 for the software license from the Franchisor.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed sale. **Note, however, that no government agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
