The Order of Registration is enclosed for the above-referenced franchisor. Pursuant to MN Statute 80C.08, the first Annual Report is due within 120 days of the franchisor's fiscal year end accompanied with a \$200 filing fee. An annual report must comply with the Minnesota Franchise Act and the 2008 NASAA Franchise Registration and Disclosure Guidelines.

An Annual Report (renewal) consists of the following:

- a. Uniform Franchise Registration Application (includes Certification Statement that must be notarized)
- b. Franchisor's Costs and Sources of Funds
- c. Uniform Consent to Service of Process (notarized, naming Minnesota Commissioner of Commerce)
- d. Franchise Seller Disclosure Form(s)
- e. Consent of Accountant
- f. Franchise Disclosure Document (highlighted to show changes, deletions and additions from the last filing)
- g. Franchise agreements (highlighted to show changes)
- h. Audited financial statements
- i. Advertising or promotional materials

If the annual report filing also contains "material changes" as defined in MN Rule 2860.2400 the filing fee of \$200.00 must be increased to include a \$100.00 amendment fee, for a total of \$300.00.

Material Changes/Amendments

Pursuant to MN Statute 80C.07, a franchise registration must be amended within 30 days after the occurrence of any material change. An amendment application must include only the Uniform Franchise Registration Application Form, the marked pages showing the changes and the \$100.00 amendment fee.

The franchisor must submit an initial application with a \$400.00 fee if any of the following apply:

- 1. The franchisor has restructured into a new entity.
- Changes have been made to the disclosure document and agreements amounting to more than 50% of the documents.
- 3. The franchise registration has been cancelled due to failure of filing a renewal.

Advertisements

Pursuant to MN Statute 80C.09, advertisements (one copy) must be filed with the Commissioner at least five (5) business days prior to the first publication and follow the standards outline in MN Rule 2860.4100.

Additional Information

Franchise Seller Disclosure Forms may be submitted at any time during the registration period. No fee is required.
