A Crazy Otto's Diner franchisee will operate a mid-scale casual dining restaurant featuring a variety of menu items including omelets, pasta, steak, seafood, and poultry.

We offer a single Crazy Otto's Diner Restaurant. The initial franchise fee is \$25,000. We do not currently offer options to obtain franchises to develop and operate a specified number of Crazy Otto's Diner restaurants under an Area Development Agreement, although we may do so in the future. The estimated initial investment required ranges from \$563,200 to \$760,400 (excluding real estate purchase).

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 days calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no government agent has verified the information contained in this document.
