Family Doctor Plus, LLC offers to franchises to licensed physicians for urgent care clinics that will offer various levels of medical and health care-related services and the equipment and supplies required to provide the services to patients under the trade name "Family MED Plus" and other related trademarks, service marks, logos and commercial symbols We offer 2 franchise programs in this Disclosure Document

<u>Single Clinic Program</u> Under this program, you will operate one Family MED Plus Clinic from a location that you select and we approve The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Family MED Plus Clinic is \$176,800 to \$772,000 This includes \$55,000 that must be paid to us or our affiliate

Area Development Program Under this program, you will agree to open and operate 2 – 3 Family MED Plus Clinics in a defined geographic area within a specified period of time. The total investment necessary to begin operation of an area development franchise for 2 – 3 Family MED Plus Clinics is approximately \$198,800 to \$805,000. This includes \$75,000 to \$85,000 that must be paid to us or our affiliate.

This Disclosure Document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English Read this Disclosure Document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this Disclosure Document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the Franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note, however, that no governmental agency has recommended or verified the information contained in this Disclosure Document.
