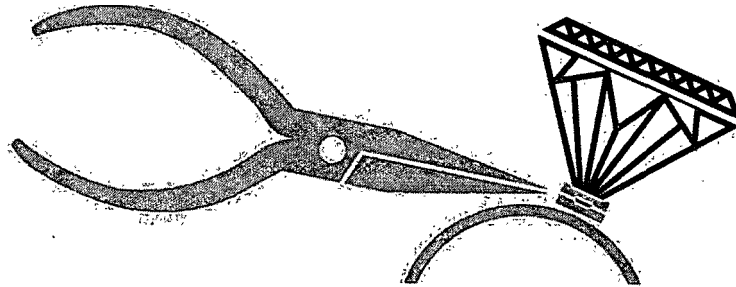

Jewelry Repair Enterprises, Inc. offers franchises for the establishment and operation of a business involving a distinctive and innovative system for the operation of a jewelry and watch repair and retail jewelry enterprise whose products and services are sold from either a kiosk or an in-line store in a shopping mall or other retail locations.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jewelry Repair Enterprises, Inc. franchised business is approximately \$158,961 – \$239,961 for a kiosk. This includes \$40,000 to \$42,700 that must be paid to the Franchisor or its affiliates. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jewelry Repair Enterprises, Inc. franchised business is \$261,961 – \$434,961 for an in-line store. This includes \$40,000 to \$42,700 that must be paid to the Franchisor or its affiliates. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jewelry Repair Enterprises, Inc. franchised business is \$142,961 – \$210,961 for a non-traditional Walmart location. This includes \$40,000 to \$42,700 that must be paid to the Franchisor or its affiliates. The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Jewelry Repair Enterprises, Inc. franchised business is \$102,961 – \$164,961 for a non-traditional Meijer location. This includes \$40,000 to \$42,700 that must be paid to the Franchisor or its affiliates.
