We franchise the right to operate a single fit20 personal training studio (each a "Studio" or "Franchised Business") focused on providing a specialized program developed around a system of strength training machines that that includes personal trainer assistance in a single, 20-minute session per week.

The estimated initial investment required for the establishment of a fit20 Franchised Business ranges from \$75,700 to \$158,900 which includes \$25,000 that must be paid to us or our affiliates prior to opening.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
