

We offer franchises for contemporary, high quality, fast casual sandwich shops with Asian inspired menu offerings operating under the Foumami trademarks and restaurant operating system (each a "Fournami restaurant" or "Restaurant").

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a single Fournami restaurant is \$353,000 to \$696,500. This amount includes an initial franchise fee of \$40,000 that is payable to us. The total investment necessary to begin operation under a Multi-Unit Development Agreement for three to five Fournami Restaurants is \$83,000 to \$125,000. This includes \$80,000 to \$120,000 that must be paid to us. There is no minimum number of Restaurants that you are required to develop under the Multi-Unit **Development Agreement.**

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar days before you sign a binding agreement. with, or make any payment to us or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. Note. however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this disclosure document.

You may wish to receive your disclosure document in another format that is more convenient for you. To discuss the availability of disclosures in different formats, contact Michael Wang, our Chief Executive Officer, at the address and telephone number listed above.

The terms of your contract will govern your franchise relationship. Do not rely on the disclosure. document alone to understand your contract. Read your entire contract carefully. Show your contract and this disclosure document to an advisor, like a lawyer or an accountant.

Your state may have a franchise law that requires a franchisor to register or file with a state franchise administrator before offering or selling in your state. MANY FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS DO NOT ALLOW YOU TO RENEW UNCONDITIONALLY AFTER THE INITIAL TERM EXPIRES. YOU MAY HAVE TO SIGN A NEW AGREEMENT WITH DIFFERENT TERMS AND CONDITIONS IN ORDER TO CONTINUE TO OPERATE YOUR BUSINESS. BEFORE YOU BUY, CONSIDER WHAT RIGHTS YOU HAVE TO RENEW YOUR FRANCHISE, IF ANY, AND WHAT TERMS YOU MIGHT HAVE TO ACCEPT IN ORDER TO RENEW.

Please consider the following RISK FACTORS before you buy this franchise:

- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS PERMIT THE FRANCHISEE TO MEDIATE OR LITIGATE ONLY IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE THE FRANCHISOR HAS ITS PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS, WHICH IS CURRENTLY IN BOSTON, MASSACHUSETTS. OUT OF STATE MEDIATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST MORE TO MEDIATE OR LITIGATE WITH THE FRANCHISOR IN MASSACHUSETTS THAN IN YOUR HOME STATE.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENTS STATE THAT THE LAW OF MASSACHUSETTS GOVERNS THE AGREEMENTS, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTIONS AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 3. THE FRANCHISOR IS AT AN EARLY STAGE OF DEVELOPMENT AND HAS A LIMITED OPERATING HISTORY. THIS FRANCHISE COULD BE A HIGHER RISK INVESTMENT THAN A SYSTEM WITH A LONGER OPERATING HISTORY.
- 4. THE FRANCHISEE OR MULTI-UNIT DEVELOPER WILL BE REQUIRED TO MAKE AN ESTIMATED INITIAL INVESTMENT RANGING FROM \$83,000 to \$696,500. THIS AMOUNT EXCEEDS THE FRANCHISOR'S STOCKHOLDERS EQUITY AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2017, WHICH IS (\$184,451.84).
- 5. ALL OWNERS OF THE FRANCHISE AND THEIR SPOUSES WILL BE REQUIRED TO EXECUTE PERSONAL GUARANTEES. THIS REQUIREMENT PLACES THE PERSONAL AND MARITAL ASSETS OF THE FRANCHISE OWNER(S) AT RISK.
- 6. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.

Local law may supersede these franchise agreement provisions. Certain states require the superseding provisions to appear in an addendum in this disclosure document. See Exhibit F.

We use the services of one or more FRANCHISE BROKERS or referral sources to assist us in selling our franchise. A franchise broker or referral source represents us, not you. We pay this person a fee for selling our franchise or referring you to us. You should be sure to do your own investigation of the franchise.
