The franchise offered is for the operation of a business that offers the public a unique yogurt shop experience where the customer can build a frozen yogurt treat using toppings from our topping bar. Your operation of this franchised opportunity will sometimes be referred to as the “Shop” or the “Franchise.”

The total investment necessary to begin operation of the Shop is \$233,750 to \$581,250. This includes \$30,250 that must be paid to us. The first five franchisees will pay a reduced initial franchise fee (IFF) of \$15,000 (for the first franchisee), \$20,000 (for each of the second and third franchisees) and \$25,000 (for each of the fourth and fifth franchisees).

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your Franchise Agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
