- 6. YOUR SPOUSE MUST ALSO SIGN A GUARANTY MAKING YOUR SPOUSE INDIVIDUALLY LIABLE FOR YOUR FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS TO THE FRANCHISOR. THE GUARANTEE WILL PLACE YOUR SPOUSE'S MARITAL AND PERSONAL ASSETS AT RISK IF YOUR FRANCHISE FAILS.
- 7. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
