The Franchise offered is for the operation of either a learning center for early learner's ages two to under six years of age ("The Lil Genius Kid®) or a learning center for kids ages six and up ("Genius Kids®) or a mobile model that offers enrichment programs for children conducted onsite at schools, community centers or other approved venues ("Genius Kids Club™) These child learning centers are based on an interactive proprietary curriculum that incorporates multi-sensory learning methods that has proven to result in the advanced development of fine motor and social skills, communication and confidence, paying the way for successful independent learning. The mobile model teaches fundamental life skills of critical thinking, confidence and speaking through proprietary software and interactive learning. These businesses are geared towards serving families who value intellectual and social development for their children under the names "The Lil Genius Kid[®]", "Genius Kids[®]" or "Genius Kids Club[™]". The Initial Franchise Fee is \$20,000 for either an accelerated learning center ("Express Model or Standard Model") with exclusive rights to operate in a specific area defined by us. The Initial Franchise Fee is \$5,000 for a mobile model with exclusive rights to operate in a specific area defined by us. Additional Franchises for a learning center is a reduced fee of \$\$18,500 per Franchise and for a mobile model \$3,000 per Franchise. The total estimated initial investment required to begin operation of a learning center Express Model \$214,900194,900 to \$564,500544,500 (both ranges exclude real estate lease/acquisition costs) depending on a number of factors that are fully discussed in Item 7. The total estimated initial investment required to operate a mobile model ranges from \$15,200 to \$35,000 also depending on a number of factors that are fully discussed in Item 7. Both initial investments include the Initial Franchise Fee of \$20,000 and \$5,000 respectively (as discussed in Item 5) that must be paid to the franchisor or affiliate.

Note 6: Interest and late charges begin to accrue from the due date of payment. You must also pay any damages, expenses, collection costs and reasonable attorney fees we incur when you do not make the required payments.

Note 7: You must protect, defend, indemnify and hold us harmless against any claims, lawsuits or losses arising out of your operation of the franchised business. If you default under the agreement and we engage an attorney for collection or enforcement, you must pay all our damages and costs to the extent permitted by law.

Note 8: We require you to join the local Chamber of Commerce, the Better Business Bureau other professional organizations we reasonably specify (Franchise Agreement Section XII.H). The cost of these organizations will vary depending on their membership requirements.
