The Franchise offered is for the operation of either a learning center for early learner's ages two to under six years of age ("The Lil Genius Kids") or a learning center for kids ages six and up ("Genius Kids" or The Genius Kids ClubTM, or a mobile model that offers enrichment programs for children conducted onsite at schools, community centers or other approved venues ("Genius Kids Club™",) These child learning centers are based on an interactive proprietary curriculum that incorporates multi-sensory learning methods that has proven to result in the advanced development of fine motor and social skills, communication and confidence, paving the way for successful independent learning. The mobile model teaches fundamental life skills of critical thinking, confidence and speaking through proprietary software and interactive learning. These businesses are geared towards serving families who value intellectual and social development for their children under the names "The Lil Genius Kid®", "Genius Kids®" or "The Genius Kids Club™ and "The Win With Words™. The total investment necessary to begin operation of an Express Franchise is \$122,200 to \$238,400. This includes \$50,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s). The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Standard Model Franchise is \$239,900 to \$619,500. This includes \$50,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s). The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Mobile Model Franchise is \$20,200 to \$40,000. This includes \$20,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or its affiliate(s).
