The franchise offered is to operate a limited-amenity Gold's Gym Express® Facility.

The total investment necessary to begin operation of a Gold's Gym Express Facility is \$951,000 to \$1,937,500. This includes \$32,500 to \$47,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate. The total investment necessary to begin operation under the Development Rights Agreement is \$55,000 to \$305,000. This includes \$50,000 to \$300,000 that must be paid to the franchisor or an affiliate.

This disclosure document summarizes certain provisions of your franchise agreement and other information in plain English. Read this disclosure document and all accompanying agreements carefully. You must receive this disclosure document at least 14 calendar-days before you sign a binding agreement with, or make any payment to, the franchisor or an affiliate in connection with the proposed franchise sale. **Note, however, that no governmental agency has verified the information contained in this document.**
