- 1. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT, IF YOU DO NOT COMPLETE THE INITIAL TRAINING PROGRAM TO OUR SATISFACTION, WE MAY TERMINATE THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT.
- 2. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT, IF YOU DO NOT SIGN A LEASE FOR A BUSINESS LOCATION WITHIN NINE MONTHS AFTER WE HAVE ACCEPTED YOU AS A FRANCHISEE, WE MAY TERMINATE THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT.
- 3. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT REQUIRES YOU TO RESOLVE DISPUTES WITH US BY ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION ONLY IN WASHINGTON. OUT-OF-STATE ARBITRATION OR LITIGATION MAY FORCE YOU TO ACCEPT A LESS FAVORABLE SETTLEMENT FOR DISPUTES. IT MAY ALSO COST YOU MORE TO ARBITRATE OR LITIGATE WITH US IN WASHINGTON THAN IN YOUR OWN STATE.
- 4. THE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT PROVIDES THAT WASHINGTON LAW GOVERNS THE AGREEMENT, AND THIS LAW MAY NOT PROVIDE THE SAME PROTECTION AND BENEFITS AS LOCAL LAW. YOU MAY WANT TO COMPARE THESE LAWS.
- 5. THERE MAY BE OTHER RISKS CONCERNING THIS FRANCHISE.
